CONWY RIVER FESTIVAL 2018 ENTRY FORM – GENERAL INFO & FAQs

Which class should I enter?	
If your boat is a <i>dayboat</i>	Open day racing boats.
If your boat is a <i>cruiser over 6m/20ft and with an NHC base number of more than 0.830</i> , you have a <i>choice</i> which cruiser class to enter:	<p>Class 1 is for 'serious' racers. NHC handicaps are used and there is also an IRC competition for those boats having an IRC rating. Courses are intended to be testing, with long beats and spinnaker runs.</p> <p>Class 2 is for more leisurely racing. This is a 'white sail' class so spinnakers, cruising chutes, bloopers and gennakers are not allowed. Courses are shorter & dead runs are avoided. NHC handicap system.</p>

Further FAQ's...	
What if my boat doesn't have an NHC number?	Go to http://www.rya.org.uk/racing/Pages/NHC.aspx for more details of the National Handicap for Cruisers system (NHC). If there's no base number listed for your boat, please enter as early as possible supplying as much information as you can about the boat and we will obtain a base number.
Will I get a discounted marina berth?	See 'Berthing Arrangements' on page 1 of this form
What do I get for my entry fee?	You will receive your boat's <i>race number</i> plus all necessary race documents (SIs, course card and marks chart). Race documents can be collected at the briefing, along with your race number. Class flags (required for cruiser classes 1&2 are not provided. A limited number of class flags may be purchased from the Race Office/at briefings or loaned for £10 (returnable).
Can I enter by email or online?	<p>Yes, entry can be completed online at conwyriverfestival.org, with online payment taken immediately. You must pay the entry fee by 30th June to get the benefit of the early entry discount.</p> <p>Your entry will not be accepted until you have paid the entry fee, either online, by cheque, or electronic bank transfer ie BACS: (<i>sort code 403007 account number 41332783</i>). Details are also available from CRF website or from sailing@conwyriverfestival.org. Before racing you must submit a signed copy of your entry form or use the online entry form.</p> <p>To enter by email, send your signed entry form in pdf or jpeg format to: sailing@conwyriverfestival.org.</p> <p>Late entries will be accepted at CRF office on payment of the full entry fee.</p>
